ABOUT RhAPP

Rheumatology Advanced Practice Providers (RhAPP) is a non-profit 501c3 organization dedicated to developing educational programs, providing professional advancement services, and assembling resources for—and guided by—advanced practice providers (APPs). Through our peer-to-peer network, we seek to support the integral role APPs play in the rheumatology healthcare community by providing the most relevant, timely information and communication for the treatment of their patients with rheumatic diseases.

Since 2019, RhAPP has established itself as the preeminent source of rheumatic disease education for APPs. The organization educates more than 1,000 APPs annually via various activities, including regional meetings designed to bring cutting-edge education to groups of APPs across the country.

2024 REGIONALS AT A GLANCE

Nurse practitioners (NPs), physician assistants (PAs), and clinical PharmDs, herein referred to as APPs, play a critical role in addressing the patient care gaps that exist because of excessive wait times in rheumatology. NPs and PAs hold prescriptive privileges in all 50 states and see an average of 82 patients per week, respectively. APPs play a critical role in the care and management of patients with rheumatic diseases, and RhAPP equips colleagues with the education, tools, and resources they need to be leaders in the field and provide unmatched care for their patients.

To meet the educational and practice needs of APPs across the US, the RhAPP Board of Directors and Education Committee will host a series of eight (8) conferences entitled **RhAPP 2024 Regional Summit Series: Guidelines and Beyond**. This regional educational series will feature an evening program focusing on hot topics in gout, psoriatic arthritis (PsA), systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE), and vasculitis. The regional summits are designed to reach community APPs who are unable to attend the annual RhAPP National Conference as well as community family/general practice NPs and PAs, nurses, and pharmacists who need updates on the latest clinical advances in rheumatic diseases.

NEW THIS YEAR—REMOTE WATCH PARTIES!

RhAPP understands the challenges busy clinicians have in attending evening meetings as well as the limitations presented by geography and travel times. To that end, the **2024 RhAPP Regional Summit Series** will include watch parties held in conjunction with each of the regional summits at each location. The satellite watch parties will be critical in furthering the educational reach into additional cities in the region as well as providing APPs with an opportunity to engage in clinical discussion throughout the meeting.

RhAPP's regional summit series will launch in May 2024 in major markets in the US and will reach approximately **300 community APPs**. The meetings will be held in New York, Chicago, Denver, Columbus, Atlanta, Phoenix, San Antonio, and Aventura.





RULES & REGULATIONS

CONFERENCE ORGANIZER

For the purpose of this document, RhAPP, Focus Medical Communications, and Tactical Advantage Group will be referred to as the Conference Organizer.

REPORTABLE EXPENSES

The Conference Organizer attests that sponsorship funds will not be used to purchase meals, snacks, or beverages for any conference or event attendee. The Conference Organizer also attests that sponsorship funds will not be used toward faculty honoraria for the duration of this conference.

CONFERENCE BADGE POLICY

Conference badges will be required to access all 2024 conference events and exhibit spaces.

PAYMENT TERMS

Confirmation of your sponsorship/exhibit space is contingent upon receiving full payment prior to the scheduled event date. Payment instructions will be provided in a confirmation email upon submission of this form. Payment due in full upon signing.

CANCELLATION POLICY

A refund, less a handling fee of 10%, will be given for cancellations received in writing within three business days after the Sponsorship/Exhibitor's Agreement is completed. After this date, no refunds will be granted unless the conference is canceled altogether.

If the conference is postponed and rescheduled within one year of the originally scheduled date, no refunds will be granted. However, the sponsorship/exhibitor fee shall be applied to the rescheduled conference. Should the conference be canceled and not take place within one year of the originally scheduled date, a full refund shall be granted.

FAILURE TO OCCUPY EXHIBIT HALL SPACE

The Conference Organizer reserves the right to reallocate any space that has not been occupied by the confirmed Exhibitor by 3:00 pm on each conference date. Should this occur, the confirmed Exhibitor agrees to forfeit their exhibit space.

SCHEDULING NON-CONFERENCE EVENTS

The Conference Organizer appreciates the convenience of having a number of key opinion leaders and APPs in one location. However, we also recognize the importance of allowing our faculty and attendees to make the most of this productive conference time. To that end, our participating Sponsors agree to the following:

- Sponsors may not schedule any meetings or events within or external to the conference venue during conference dates and times without the explicit permission of the Conference Organizer.
- Sponsors may request to schedule an on-site meeting or event outside conference dates and times by submitting their written request to the Conference Organizer no later than 30 days prior to each conference date.
